Dear Mr. Harris,

I am counsel of record for Petitioners Tyson Timbs and a 2012 Land Rover LR2 in the above-captioned case.

The Court granted our petition for a writ of certiorari on June 18, 2018. Accordingly, Petitioners' brief on the merits and the joint appendix are due on August 2, 2018. Argument in this case will not take place before October 2018.

Pursuant to Rule 30.4, Petitioners request a 33-day extension of time in which to file their merits brief and the joint appendix, making Petitioners' merits brief and the appendix due no later than Tuesday, September 4, 2018. (Subject to the Court's approval, this extension would make Respondent's brief due Thursday, October 4, 2018, and Petitioners' reply brief due Monday, November 5, 2018.) Petitioners' requested extension would allow counsel to complete several other pressing litigation projects while the Court is in recess, and it would provide them with the time necessary to fully research and brief the historical materials bearing on the question presented.

Counsel for Respondent does not oppose the requested extension.
