A response in this death penalty case is due March 7, 2018. Respondent respectfully requests a thirty-day extension of the present deadline, up to and including April 6, 2018. This is Respondent's first request for an extension in this case. The extension request is not sought for an improper purpose, including harassment or unnecessary delay. Rather, the undersigned requires additional time due to the demands of a capital caseload, primarily the litigation related to the then-pending execution of Thomas Whitaker. *See* Brief in Opposition, *Whitaker v.
