A response in this death penalty case is due April 6, 2018. Respondent respectfully requests a thirty-one-day extension of the present deadline, up to and including May 7, 2018. This is Respondent's second request for an extension in this case. The extension request is not sought for an improper purpose, including harassment or unnecessary delay. Rather, the undersigned requires additional time due to the demands of a capital caseload, primarily work concerning another capitally-sentenced Texas inmate whose prior litigation resulted in an opinion from this Court. Skinner v. Switzer, 562 U.S. 521 (2011); see State's Notice of Filing Proposed Findings of Fact, State v. Skinner, No. 5216 (31st Dist. Ct. Gray County, Tex. Apr. 2, 2018). The undersigned conferred with Petitioner's counsel, Bryce Benjet, who stated that he was not opposed to this requested extension. A copy of this letter will be sent to Mr. Benjet.
