Dear Clerk Harris:

I represent Respondents in the above-captioned matter. The petition for a writ of certiorari in this case was filed on February 16, 2018, and placed on the docket on February 21, 2018. Respondents' brief in opposition to the petition is presently due on March 23, 2018.

We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the rules of this Court, an extension of time to and including April 23, 2018 (April 22, 2018, is a Sunday), within which to file a brief in opposition.

The extension is necessary because the attorneys with principal responsibility for the preparation of the brief have been heavily engaged with the press of other matters, including the preparation of a writ of certiorari to be filed with this Court in early March in *Cassirer v. Thyssen-Bornemisza Collection Foundation*, 862 F.3d 951 (9th Cir. 2017). In addition, the extension requested will allow Respondents time to consider and, if necessary, respond to the briefs of *amici curiae* expected to be filed in this case on or before March 23, 2018. I have conferred with Counsel of Record for the Petitioner, who consents to this extension.
