Dear Mr. Harris:

As counsel of record for the Respondents, Los Angeles World Airports and the City of Los Angeles, I write to request an extension of time to file a brief in opposition to the petition for certiorari in this case, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4. The Respondents' brief is presently due March 26, 2018. I request a 30-day extension of time through and including April 25, 2018.

The Respondents have received notice under Rule 37.2(a) that four organizations will be filing separate briefs as *amici curiae* in support of the Petitioners: American Trucking Associations, Inc., National Right to Work Legal Defense Foundation, U.S. Chamber Litigation Center, and International Air Transport Association. I request a 30-day extension of time to allow the Respondents to review and, if warranted, respond to any new information or arguments raised in those four *amicus* briefs. Without an extension, the Respondents would be unable to respond to the *amicus* briefs because, under Rule 37, they are due at the same time that the Respondents' brief in opposition is currently due to be filed.

I have consulted with counsel for Petitioners regarding this request and have been informed by Anthony J. Dick of Jones Day that Petitioners consent to the requested 30-day extension.
