TO THE HONORABLE STEPHEN BREYER, ASSOCIATE JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT OF THE UNITED STATES AND CIRCUIT JUSTICE FOR THE FIRST CIRCUIT:

Pursuant to Rule 30.3, Petitioner New Prime, Inc., respectfully requests a seven-day extension of time in which to file its reply brief on the merits to and including August 24, 2018.

1. On June 8, 2018, Respondent Dominic Oliveira filed a motion requesting a seven-day extension of time to file his response brief in addition to the thirty-day extension previously granted by the Clerk of the Court on March 9, 2018. New Prime consented to the additional extension and, in turn, Oliveira consented to the present application for an equal extension of time for New Prime to file its reply brief. Cal.), the first day of which is scheduled for August 14, 2018; an opening brief in *Bahamas Surgery Center, LLC v. Kimberly-Clark Corp.*, No. 18-55478 (9th Cir.), due to be filed on August 22, 2018; and a petition for a writ of certiorari in *Kimberly-Clark Corp. v. Davidson*, No. 18A33, due to be filed on September 6, 2018.

4. New Prime's requested seven-day extension of time will not prejudice the Court or the parties, given that oral argument has been set for October 3, 2018.

5. Counsel for Oliveira has no objection to this request.
