Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on July 6, 2017. The government filed its brief in opposition on September 11, 2017. On October 12, 2017, the parties filed a joint motion to defer consideration of the petition because the parties had reached a settlement in principle. The Court granted the parties' motion to defer consideration of the petition on October 30, 2017.

On June 8, 2018, petitioners moved, pursuant to Rule 46 of the Rules of this Court, to dismiss the petition for a writ of certiorari in light of the parties' final settlement. The United States agrees that the motion to dismiss should be granted, the petition should be dismissed, and the parties should bear their own costs associated with the petition.
