In accordance with Rule 30(4), please consider this letter as the State of New Hampshire's motion to extend time to file its Brief in Opposition to Endo Pharmaceuticals, Inc.'s Petition for a Writ of Certiorari. The State of New Hampshire respectfully requests a 14-day extension of the January 16, 2018 deadline, which would result in a new deadline of January 30, 2018.
