Pursuant to S. Ct. R. 15.3 and 30.4, Respondent Alerus Financial, N.A. respectfully moves for an extension of 60 days to respond to the petition for a writ of certiorari filed in this matter, to and including February 5, 2018. Absent an extension of time, Alerus's response would be due on December 6, 2017. Petitioners do not oppose this request.

On August 4, 2017, Petitioners Pioneer Centres Holding Company Stock Ownership Plan and Its Trustees, Robert Jensen and Susan Dukes, petitioned Justice Sotomayor for a 60-day extension of time within which to file a petition for a writ of certiorari.
