Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed October 31, 2017 and placed on the docket on November 6, 2017. The government's response is now due, after one extension, on August 27, 2018. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including September 28, 2018, within which to file the government's response.
