MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

Pursuant to Rule 39 and 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(d)(7), Cross-Petitioner asks leave to file the accompanying Conditional Cross-Petition without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
