
Honorable Clerk:

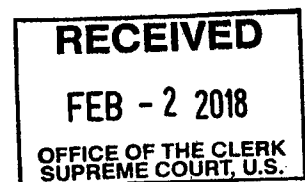
