Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in this case was filed on January 8, 2018. The response to the petition is currently due on or before February 9, 2018. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, Respondents respectfully request that the time for filing a response to the petition be extended by 60 days, to and including April 10, 2018.

Respondents submit this request because undersigned counsel for Respondents has been on paternity leave since before the petition was filed and will remain on leave until February 5, 2018.
