Second Motion to Extend Time to File Response to Petition for Writ

Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondent respectfully moves for a second extension of the time for filing a response to the petition for writ of certiorari in *Ogle v. Texas*, No. 18-1182.

This Court requested a response on April 22, 2019, and granted Respondent's first request for a 30-day extension, making the current due date June 21, 2019. A second 30-day extension, which would push the deadline to July 22, 2019, is needed because of the press of business from numerous, complex matters with deadlines near the current deadline which require significant time and attention from the undersigned counsel and other counsel assisting with this matter:
