
I am counsel of record for the plaintiffs Marlyn Sali, et al., the respondents in this case. The response to the petition is currently due on May 2, 2019. I am writing to request a 30-day extension of the deadline to file a response, to and including June 2, 2019. The petitioner does not oppose this request.

I and other attorneys at my firm will have principal responsibility for preparing the brief in opposition to the petition. We have several proximate deadlines and obligations that have prevented and will continue to prevent us from devoting adequate time to the response absent an extension. These include an oral argument before the California Superior Court on April 15; a response to a petition for review due on April 16 in the Supreme Court of California; a reply brief due on April 19 in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit; an appellate brief due on April 22 in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit; an amicus brief due on April 26 in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit; an appellate brief due on April 29 in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit; two responses to petitions for writ of certiorari due in this Court on April 29 and May 1 (Nos. 18-1116, 18A-660).

A 30-day extension will allow me and my colleagues to balance these other responsibilities with our obligations in this case.
