I represent the respondents, Spencer Harris and Brad Bracey, in the above captioned matter. The petition for certiorari was filed on April 8, 2019, and respondents waived their response on April 17, 2019. The Court requested a response on May 1, 2019, and it is currently due on May 31, 2019.

I respectfully request a 30 day extension under Rule 30.4. During the response period, I have been preparing for a multi-week trial and filing an unexpected motion for interlocutory appeal.
