A petition for certiorari has been filed in the above-captioned case. The State intends to file a brief in opposition, which is currently due May 19, 2019.

We expect multiple amicus briefs to be filed in this matter. In addition, our office is responding to multiple new petitions being filed after certiorari was granted in *Ramos v. Louisiana* (18-5924) and the State's merits stage brief in *Ramos* is due in mid-August. Considering the complexity of the issues involved in *June Medical* and our office's other pending matters before the Court, the State requests an extension of sixty days in which to file its brief in opposition.
