JURISDICTION

This application for extension is filed greater than 10 days prior to the 90 day deadline for filing a petition. The final opinion of the Washington State Supreme Court was entered on November 28, 2018. Under 28 U.S.C. 1257, this Court has jurisdiction to review this opinion. This application is filed at least 10 day in advance of this deadline.

REASONS FOR GRANTING THE EXTENSION

The Petitioner is currently incarcerated. He was represented by counsel in the appeals process in Washington state, but is now self represented. He is working through his mother Michelle Anderson, to draft and file a petition. Due to the excessive burdens of incarceration, and the lack of timely access to research materials and communications, the Petitioner is in dire need of a sixty day extension.
