On October 15, 2019, the Court invited the Solicitor General to file in case No. 18-1401 a brief expressing the views of the United States. On March 20, 2020, the Solicitor General submitted a brief for the United States as amicus curiae in case No. 18-1401. Consistent with Supreme Court Rule 15.8, Linear Controls, Incorporated will file a supplemental brief in response to the Solicitor General's amicus brief.
