
Re: *Seeberger v. Davenport Civil Rights Commission; et al.*, No. 18-1445

Dear Mr. Bickell:

I am counsel for Respondent Michelle Schreurs in the above case. On May 20, a certiorari petition was docketed in this case. The response is due on June 19, 2019. For the reasons set out below, and pursuant to Rule 30.4, I respectfully request an extension of 30 days, up to and including July 19, 2019.

I did not represent Ms. Schreurs in the earlier proceedings. I was retained only recently to prepare and file an opposition in this case. I require the additional 30 days to review the record and prepare a response that adequately addresses the points raised in the petition. Two amicus briefs in support of the petition are being filed on June 19, a response to which could only be prepared after that date. Your office earlier granted a 30-day extension to the other respondent in this case, the Davenport Civil Rights Commission.
