Dear Mr. Harris:

A conditional cross-petition for certiorari has been filed in the above-captioned case. Cross-Respondents intend to file a brief in opposition, which is currently due June 24, 2019, and write to request an extension of sixty days. The new due date would be August 23, 2019. This request is unopposed.

The conditional cross-petition presents two questions, neither of which was raised in the proceedings below. Additional time is requested so that Cross-Respondents may adequately consider and respond to the new arguments Cross-Petitioner has raised. Cross-Respondents also expect amicus briefs will be filed in support of the Cross-Petitioner, to which Cross-Respondents would like the opportunity to respond in the brief in opposition. Additionally, counsel for Cross-Respondents is a public interest legal organization dedicated to reproductive rights and has several active litigations in which briefs are due in the next 60 days.

The conditional cross-petition was filed in response to the petition for certiorari filed in *June Medical Services L.L.C., et al. v. Gee,* No. 18-1323. The Court previously granted Cross-Petitioner, Dr. Rebekah Gee, a sixty-day extension to file a brief in opposition to that petition for certiorari. Dr. Gee, through counsel, has represented that she does not oppose this request for a reciprocal sixty-day extension.
