The petition for a writ of certiorari in this case was filed on June 4, 2019. A response is due, without extension, on July 8, 2019. The City of Chicago hereby requests a 30-day extension of time, to and including August 7, 2019, within which to file our response to the petition. We request this extension because of the press of work on other matters pending before this Court and another filing that could not be extended. The City was a plaintiff in <u>Department of Commerce v. New York</u>, No. 18-966, in which there were several filings this week. We also filed a supplemental brief in support of our petition for certiorari in <u>Winstead v. Johnson</u>, No. 18-1013, on June 21, 2019. Finally, on June 24, 2019, we filed in opposition to a petition for permission to appeal under Fed. R. Civ. P. 23(f) from the denial of class certification in Smith v. City of Chicago, No. 19-8014 (7th Cir.).
