After carefully considering the filings, we grant the government's motion for summary disposition and dismiss the appeal. The appellant waived the issue of the enforceability of the appellate waiver by failing to develop relevant argument in its opening brief. See United States v. Torres-Estrada, 817 F.3d 376, 378 (1st Cir. 2016); United States v. Arroyo-Blas, 783 F.3d 361, 367 (1st Cir. 2015). Moreover, even if we were to consider them, Appellant's arguments in its opposition to the government's motion for summary disposition are undeveloped and untenable. The risk of unforeseen error is a normal consequence of an appellate waiver. See United States v. Blick, 408 F.3d 162, 170 (4th Cir. 2005); *see also* United States v. Sahlin, 399 F.3d 27, 31 (1st Cir. 2005). Appellant

established no basis to avoid the waiver. *See* United States v. Donath, 616 F.3d 80, 84 (1st Cir. 2010).
