
Dear Mr. Harris:

The North Carolina Justice Center represents Respondents in the above-referenced case. I write to request an extension of time for filing a brief in opposition to the petition for writ of certiorari. Petitioner's petition for certiorari was docketed on August 14, 2018, and Respondents' brief in opposition is currently due on September 17, 2018.

The North Carolina Justice Center, lead counsel in this case, is a nonprofit organization that advocates to protect and expand the rights of workers, consumers, immigrants, and low-income families, including through litigation. We request an extension to provide sufficient time for the Justice Center to prepare an opposition while also complying with an array of other deadlines and obligations which predate the filing of Petitioner's petition for certiorari. An extension will allow us to meet these obligations and also to file a response that adequately addresses the points raised in the petition for certiorari. Pursuant to Rule 30.4 of the United States Supreme Court, Respondents request an extension of thirty (30) days to file a brief in opposition, creating a new deadline of October 17, 2018 for the submission of this brief.
