Dear Mr. Harris:

I am counsel of record for respondent in *South Carolina v. Samuel*, No. 18-238. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, respondent requests that the date for responding to the petition for certiorari be extended an additional 30 days, to and including November 23, 2018. The petition was filed on August 23, 2018 and the brief in opposition was originally due on September 24, 2018. On that date, the Court granted a 30-day extension of time to and including Oct. 24, 2018.

This extension will allow the case to be better presented to the Court. Counsel is representing respondent pro bono as part of the University of Virginia School of Law Supreme Court Litigation Clinic and has been busy completing petitioner's merits reply brief in *Culbertson v. Berryhill*, No. 17-73, which was filed last week. He is now busy preparing for oral argument in that case, which is scheduled for Nov. 7, 2018.
