In order to proceed against the President in his official capacity, there must be a waiver of sovereign immunity that permits such an action, based on the factual allegations of the complaint. The complaint does not cite any such authority, and there are no factual allegations in the complaint, as that term is commonly understood, much less any factual allegations that would suggest the existence of a waiver of sovereign immunity. To the extent that plaintiff may be attempting to sue the President in his personal capacity, such an attempt is precluded by *Nixon v. Fitzgerald*, 457 U.S. 731 (1982) (in light of the special nature of the President's constitutional office and functions, absolute presidential immunity exists from damages liability for acts within the outer perimeter of the President's official responsibility).

The complaint should also be dismissed under Rule 12(b)(6) for failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted. The complaint and its attachments appear to relate to issues of theological doctrine, not factual issues that can be resolved by a federal court. As explained in *Ashcroft v. Saints (hereafter, "Church"), which is described as appearing pro se; and Xiu Jian Sun, who characterizes himself as "the spiritual Adam" and who is also described on the docket as appearing pro se. The defendant is President Trump. Appellant Xiu filed this case, but there is no indication that he is a lawyer or that he has in any way been authorized to file the case on behalf of the Church.

The complaint does not contain factual allegations as that term is commonly understood. Instead, it appears to make a theological argument, e.g., the first paragraph states "Lord god of host [sic] sent the messenger through angel said to spiritual Adam: **take him (her) to the law to confront it.**" [emphasis in original.]

## II.

In the District Court, appellee moved to dismiss the case pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure ("Rule") 12(b)(1) (no waiver of sovereign immunity that would permit subject matter jurisdiction over the President) and 12(b)(6) (failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted). Appellee also argued that the Church should be dismissed as a party: An artificial entity, whether a corporation or some other non-natural person, can only act in court through agents.

The District Court dismissed the case without prejudice. It agreed with appellee "that Plaintiffs

can be resolved by a court. As explained in *Ashcroft v. Iqbal*, 556 U.S. 662, 678-79 (2009), Rule 8 "marks a notable and generous departure from the hyper-technical code-pleading regime of a prior era, but it does not unlock the doors of discovery for a plaintiff armed with nothing more than conclusions." "To survive a motion to dismiss, a complaint must contain sufficient factual matter, accepted as true, to 'state a claim to relief that is plausible on its face.'" *Id.* at 678 (emphasis added). Furthermore, a complaint may be dismissed on jurisdictional grounds when it "is 'patently insubstantial,' presenting no federal question suitable for decision." *Tooley v. Napolitano*, 586 F.3d 1006, 1009 (D.C. Cir. 2009) (quoting *Best v. Kelly*, 39 F.3d 328, 330 (D.C. Cir. 1994)). In addition, the "federal courts are without power to entertain claims otherwise within their jurisdiction if they are 'so attenuated and unsubstantial as to be absolutely devoid of merit.'" *Hagans v. Lavine*, 415 U.S. 528, 536-7 (1974) (quoting *Newburyport Water Co. v. Newburyport*, 193 U.S. 561, 579 (1904)).

Furthermore, the Church cannot appear *pro se*. *Rowland v. Cal. Men's Colony, Unit II Men's Advisory Council*, 506 U.S. 194, 202 (1993) (a corporation or other non-natural person can only act in court through agents). There is no attorney representing the Church in this action. This provides an additional ground for dismissing the Church. As previously noted, there is nothing in the record indicating or suggesting that the
