Dear Clerk of the Court:

I write to request a 30-day extension of the deadline to file the Response Brief in Opposition to the State of Missouri's Petition for Writ of Certiorari, to and including December 21, 2018, Prior to this Court's Request for Response, Douglass and Gaulter instructed me not to file a Response in this matter.
