

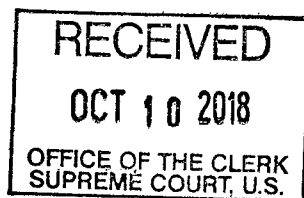
**RESPONDENT'S MOTION
