Dear Mr. Harris:

I represent Petitioners in the above-captioned case. The petition for a writ of certiorari was docketed on September 18, 2018, and the response is due on November 19, 2018. By this letter, Petitioners waive the 14-day waiting period for a reply brief under Rule 15.5 and ask that the petition, response, and amicus briefs be distributed on the next scheduled distribution date—November 20—for consideration at the December 7 conference.

As explained in the petition, this case is an ideal companion case to American Legion v. American Humanist Association (No. 17-1717) and Maryland-National Capital Park & Planning Commission v. American Humanist Association (No. 18-18), in which the Court granted certiorari on November 2. If the Court grants certiorari in this case, Petitioners are prepared to file their opening brief on the same day that opening briefs in American Legion are due—currently December 17, 2018—to ensure that the cases can be heard and decided together.
