FORMA PAUPERIS**



The Petitioner, ANDRES LOPEZ-MARTINEZ, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, hereby moves this Court for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

1. Mr. Lopez-Martinez was determined to be indigent pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, by a judge of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia. Undersigned counsel was appointed to represent Mr. Lopez-Martinez in the district court and on appeal before the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.
