

This Matter Coming On To Be Heard before the undersigned Superior Court Judge, the Court makes the following findings of fact:

1. This defendant was found guilty of 2 counts of PWISD a Schedule I Controlled Substance, Felony Maintaining a Dwelling to Keep/Sell Controlled Substances and Habitual Felon.
2. In State v. Williams, State v. Williams, 774 S.E.2d 880, the North Carolina Court of Appeals vacated one of the PWISD convictions due to an improper indictment amendment. The defendant's remaining convictions remain undisturbed.
3. The defendant has filed a *pro se* motion for appropriate relief (hereinafter MAR).
4. The Court has reviewed the defendant's MAR, the State's response and all Exhibits.
5. The Court notes that the defendant's cases were heard in the North Carolina Court of Appeals: State v. Williams, 774 S.E.2d 880; State v. Williams, 796 S.E.2d 823; petition for discretionary reviewed by denied by the North Carolina Supreme Court: see State v. Williams 799 S.E.2d 624.

Based Upon The Foregoing Findings Of Fact, the Court concludes as a Matter Of Law:

1. The Court has jurisdiction to hear this matter.
2. The defendant has asserted no grounds, either in law or in equity, upon which his requested relief should be granted.
3. The defendant's MAR should be denied.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the defendant's motion for appropriate relief is and in all respects DENIED.

WHEREFORE IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant's failure to assert any other grounds in the current Motion shall be subject to being treated in the future as a Procedural Bar to any other claims, assertions, petitions or motions that the Defendant might hereafter file in this matter, pursuant to N.C.G.S. 15A-1419.
