PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915 and this Court's Rule 39.1, the petitioner, above named, moves for leave to proceed in forma pauperis. In support of her motion, she states:

1. This proceeding is a petition for a writ of certiorari to review the judgment and order of the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit, filed on February 26, 2018, summarily affirming the petitioner's judgment of criminal forfeiture in a federal drug case. See Pet. Appx. A.

2. Undersigned counsel was appointed by the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania (Rufe, J.) on February 11, 2016, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(a)(1)(A), 3006A(c), to replace prior CJA counsel and to represent the petitioner at sentencing. That appointment continued for direct appeal to the Third Circuit. *Id.* § 3006A(c).

3. Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(d)(7) and this Court's Rule 39.1, no affidavit of poverty is attached.

WHEREFORE, the petitioner prays that this Court grant her leave to proceed in forma pauperis.
