**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS***

**Capital Case**

Counsel for Petitioner, **Norberto Pietri**, asks leave of this Court to proceed *in forma pauperis* in this proceeding. Petitioner has been found indigent by each state and federal court in which he has challenged this conviction and sentence and has been permitted to proceed *in forma pauperis* before each of those courts: the Florida Supreme Court; the Circuit Court of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit in and for Palm Beach County, Florida; the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida; and the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.

Capital Collateral Regional Counsel-South (CCRC-South) is a state agency in Florida charged with the statutory responsibility of providing legal representation in both state and federal capital postconviction proceedings to people convicted and sentenced to death in Florida. Part IV, Chapter 27, Florida Statutes (1994), is the CCRC-South enabling statute. CCRC-South, or its predecessor Capital Collateral Representative (CCR), have been the counsel of record for Petitioner in his postconviction proceedings since 1994, when his direct appeal was decided by the Florida Supreme Court. The undersigned counsel is a member of the Bar of this Court and is an attorney employed by CCRC-South.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner requests permission to proceed in this action *in forma pauperis*.
