

MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN *FORMA PAUPERIS*

Comes the petitioner, Arthur Wayne Kniffley, by counsel, and respectfully moves the Court for leave to file the accompanying Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit without prepayment of fees or costs and to proceed in *forma pauperis* pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39.
