### ORDER

The Appellee, Frank Stephen Buck, having requested dismissal of this appeal as untimely and frivolous and, pursuant to Rule 38, Ala. R. App. P., sanctions against the Appellant, Kimberly Baltimore, based on the alleged frivolous nature of this appeal;

And this request having been presented to and considered by the Court;
