
JENNIFER VAUGHAN'S RESPONSE TO PETITION Re: No. 18-5316

I, Jennifer Vaughan, who was named by the Court as respondent to this case, am writing to inform the Court and parties that I support granting the petition.

I was named respondent on the original Complaint for Custody that my mother, Susan Vaughan, filed in December, 2014, and I approved of her effort to obtain temporary custody of my son while I was recovering from illness.

By the time the case was heard in May, 2016, Currituck Department of Social Services had unlawfully taken custody, and my mother was also challenging the legitimacy of that custody case. I believe my name should have been removed as a party by the time the case and her Motion challenging jurisdiction were heard.


