**MOTION TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS***

***THIS IS A CAPITAL CASE***

Petitioner, Troy Victorino., respectfully moves to proceed *in forma pauperis* (“IFP”), pursuant to Rule 39 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, in connection with his filing of a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari. Petitioner is an indigent prisoner on Florida’s death row.

Petitioner was previously granted IFP status by Florida’s state court. Counsel of record, Christopher J. Anderson, was appointed to represent the indigent Petitioner by the Volusia County, Florida, Court, Case Number 04-01378 CFAWS under Fla. Crim. Pro. Rule 3.111 and Rule 3.112, in approximately February of 2010. The State of Florida paid all of Defendant’s fees and costs based on

Petitioner's indigence. Also, the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida, Orlando Division, Case No. 6:14-cf-00188, appointed the undersigned to represent the indigent Petitioner at the public's expense in such related and ensuing federal habeas corpus proceeding. Such proceedings arose out of the same murder prosecution that is the subject of the present Petition for Writ of Certiorari. Petitioner remains incarcerated at Death Row, Union Correctional Institution, Raiford, Florida. Petitioner remains indigent.
