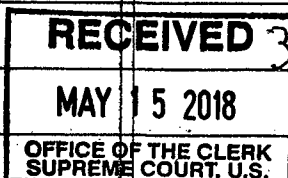

COMES NOW, Gregory Bartunek with
a ~~Motion~~ ^{Application} to Extend the Time to File a
Writ of Certiorari regarding Interlocutory
Appeal 17-3593 on a Judgment from the
8th Circuit Court of Appeals on December
20, 2017 and Order denying a Petition for
Re-Hearing on February 15, 2018.

Jurisdiction in this Court to grant
this ~~Motion~~ ^{Application} is 28 U.S.C. § 1254, Court Rule 12.
Grounds to grant motion:

1. Bartunek's Panel Attorney, Andrew
Wilson, refuses to assist Bartunek
in filing the "writ of certiorari."

2. The writ is timely, has merit,
and raises questions of law that
have not but should be addressed
by this Court.



3. Douglas County Department of
Corrections (DCDC) will only
allow me 1 hr/week in Law Library

Even though their inmate manual states up to 5 hrs/week if staying available. I know for a fact that staying is available as they can accommodate up to 60 people a day to attend the Law Library and I have seen ~~at most~~ on the average of only 6/hr on 36 a day.

4. My trial is not till August 27, 2018 so the writs will be ripe for hearing. In addition considering the time for appeals + sentencing I will remain incarcerated for up to a year or more and the writ deals with pre-trial release. If charges are dismissed or a mistrial the it will continue to be a problem where I could be kept incarcerated until charges are refiled or a new trial.

5. I need at least 10 more hours or 10 weeks, plus 1 week for mail time. So request earliest to July 7, 2018. June 1, 2018
