Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on June 20, 2018. The Court called for a response on September 18, 2018. The government's response is now due, after first extension, on November 19, 2018. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including December 19, 2018, within which to file the government's response.

This extension is necessary because the attorneys with principal responsibility for final preparation of the government's response have been heavily engaged with the press of other matters before the Court.
