
The petitioner asks leave to file the attached petition for a writ of certiorari without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

The initial action, a case filed by myself as a stockholder of the respondent corporation ASRC to compel inspection of the corporation's books and records and seeking the statutory penalty for the corporation's refusal to allow inspection, has drug on for nine (9) years now due to the Alaska court's refusal to enforce the state inspection statute on behalf of stockholder's as the statute is intended, the statute which is also the subject of the Petition for Certiorari in this matter. The continuing litigation has prevented me from seeking and obtaining paid employment as this and the other related cases have become a virtual full time job pursued on behalf of myself and other ASRC and now, with this Petition, all Alaska corporate stockholders.
