

MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

NOW Comes, Donell Thomas, Petitioner, Non-Lawyer, Pro-Se, petitioning this Honourable Court to reconsider its October 1st, 2018 order denying the Petitioner's motion to proceed in forma pauperis and its request for the Petitioner's brief to comply with Rule 33.1 of the Rules of this Court. The Petitioner prays this Honourable Court would reconsider its ruling for the following reasons:

- 1) The Petitioner is currently incarcerated at a Federal Prison Camp in Oxford, WI., where he has been confined at since February 5, 2013.
- 2) The Petitioner was granted leave to proceed in forma pauperis in the matter before this Honourable Court at both the District Court and Seventh Circuit Court of Appeals.
- 3) The Petitioner's current salary from the Federal Bureau of Prisons is about \$60.90/month, (See attached Exhibit A) of which \$25.00/month is withheld to pay the Petitioner's Federal Restitution Payment.
- 4) The Federal Prison Camp where the Petitioner is currently

held, offers access currently for legal work to a "NEO" word processing unit, which to the Petitioner's knowledge, does not allow the Petitioner to adjust the settings to format his brief before this Honourable Court according to standards set forth in Rule 33.1 of this Honourable Court. Access to Microsoft Word for legal work is currently not permitted at Oxford Federal Prison Camp.

For the reasons set forth, the Petitioner prays this Honourable Court would reconsider its October 1, 2018 decision. The Petitioner has also attached as Exhibit A his account statement for the past 90 days.
