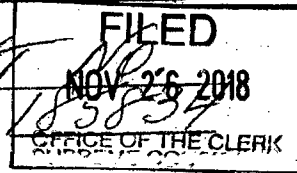

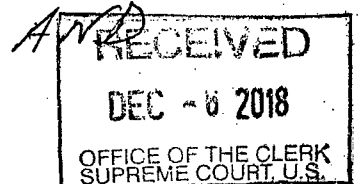

MOTION FOR ADMISSION ON NEGLIGENCE

THE FOLLOWING ARE HERE BY DEFINED AS UNFAIR METHODS OF NEGLIGENCE AND FEDERAL CIVIL RIGHTS VIOLATION INFLECTED ON VETERAN- PLAINTIFF FROM VETERAN CLINICS AND VETERAN HOSPITALS. QUESTIONS ONE THROUGH SIX ON WRIT OF CERTIORARI FOR 185834 DATED AUGUST 18, 2018 WAS NOT FULLY INVESTIGATED AND REVIEWED BY CLERK OF COURT, CASE ANALYST LISA NESBITT JAKE LIVINGSTON, AND JEFF ATKINS FOR A FINAL DECISION AND DETERMINATION. 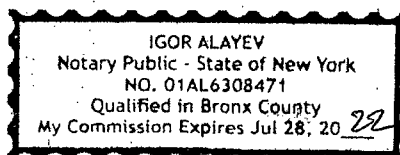
