Re: Nielsen v. Batalla Vidal, No. 18-589, Request for Extension of Time

Dear Mr. Harris,

I write regarding the above-captioned matter, on behalf of the state respondents.

Petitioners filed a petition for certiorari before judgment on November 5, 2018, and responses to the petition are currently due on December 5. On November 19, however, petitioners filed a supplemental brief in *U.S. Dep't of Homeland Sec. v. Regents of the Univ. of California*, No. 18-587 (U.S.), that included certain additional arguments for granting certiorari before judgment in No. 18-589. And on November 27, petitioners filed a corrected supplemental brief in No. 18-587 that further modified their arguments concerning the petition docketed at No. 18-589. In addition, we have been notified that at least three amicus briefs supporting the petition will be filed by December 5.

In order to take due account of these intervening developments and filings, and to allow for appropriate internal review and approval by the state respondents, the state respondents respectfully request that their time for filing a response be extended by twelve days, to and including December 17, 2018. I am authorized to inform the Court that all respondents in No. 18-589 join in this request. Counsel for petitioners have indicated that they do not oppose this request.
