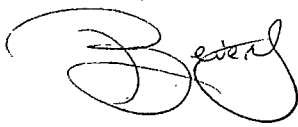

This petition for Rehearing is presented in good faith, with reasonable cause, which is to safeguard her substantial rights, and to promote "uniformity" amongst federal courts.

Ms. Baker expresses a sincere belief, that this petition contains intervening circumstances of substantial effect, and that review by this Court is necessary to ensure the "uniformity" in constitutional interpretation, throughout the federal courts. Nowhere is the need for uniformity more pressing than to ensure "uniformity" in the rules governing conviction and sentencing imposed by different federal courts for similar criminal conduct. The lack of uniformity can have important consequences for criminal defendants. Ms. Baker's case illustrates the Fourth Circuit's position of departure from the accepted and usual course of judicial proceedings, and she now pleads with this honorable court to defer her case to the Fourth Circuit for clean up.
