



I was in detention from June 7, 2017 until June 5, 2018. This case has absorbed nearly every waking hour and available dollar since October 13, 2016, including 6 Court appearances, 3 of which were in Tulsa Oklahoma, 1,500 miles away, a place I had never been nor had any inkling to visit at my own expense.

Currently, under probationary restrictions, the bulk of my earning potential is out of reach.

Professionally, I design, build & repair high-speed automated machinery. Doing so requires interstate travel with little notice. I am barred from any interstate travel without prior approval by U.S. Probation which can take weeks to obtain. This eliminates most potential earnings from these skills.

I also perform computer and network setup & repair. I am currently barred from accessing any device that can be connected to the internet without that device first having software installed on it that allows the USDOJ to monitor all activity performed on that device, and be privy to all data on that device which would include the proprietary business information of the client, and at a cost of \$50 per device and \$35 per month for each device. This eliminates 100% of potential income from these skills.

A ruling from this Court that is favorable to my, and 320 million other American's First Amendment rights will remedy this injustice. At such time I will be ready, willing and able to pay the costs of this process.
