Dear Mr. Harris:

On November 2, 2018, Petitioner StarLink Logistics, Inc. (“StarLink”) filed a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari before this Court. On November 14, 2018, your office extended the time for all respondents to file their briefs in opposition to the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to January 7, 2019.

StarLink and ACC, LLC (“ACC”) (collectively, “Parties”) are now engaged in settlement discussions. Counsel for the Parties have conferred and agree to this joint request for an additional thirty-day extension of time, until and including February 6, 2019, for all respondents to file their briefs in opposition to the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari. *See* Sup.
