OR HEARINGS. THERE WERE ORDERS EMBODYING THE
TERMS FROM PLAINTIFF AGREED UPON BUT NEVER
ENFORCED BY SUPREME COURT WASHINGTON D.C.
IF AND WHEN THESE LAWS CAN BE EXECUTED
IT WOULD BE MOST BENEFICIAL TO PLAINTIFFS,
PETITIONERS, APPELLANT RESPONDENTS CLAIM
AND HEALTH.

CONCLUSION

The petition for a writ of certiorari should be granted.
