Respondent Warden's counsel respectfully requests a 21-day extension for filing his brief in opposition to the petition for writ of certiorari. Respondent's brief is currently due in this Court on November 23, 2018. Undersigned counsel has the following responsibilities during the current briefing time period: 1) on October 26, 2018, a brief in opposition was filed in this Court in the case of *Ray Jefferson Cromartie v. Eric Sellers, Warden*, Case No. 18-5796; 2) on November 13, 2018, a response brief of Appellee will be filed in the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals in the case of *Lyndon Fitzgerald Pace v. Warden, GDCP*, Case No. 16-10868; and 3) on December 6, 2018, a response brief of Appellee will be filed in the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals in the case of *Askia Raheem v. GDCP Warden*, Case No. 17-12866. Additionally, undersigned counsel will be on military duty with the United States Army Reserve from November 1, 2018 until November 10, 2018.

Given these responsibilities, a 21-day extension until December 14, 2018, would ensure that counsel for Respondent has adequate time to properly respond to Morrow's petition for writ of certiorari. Opposing counsel has been consulted and they do not oppose the request.
