Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on October 18, 2018. Although the government waived its right to file a response, the Court has requested that a response be filed. After one prior 30-day extension, the government's response is now due on January 16, 2019. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including February 15, 2019, within which to file a response.

This extension is necessary because the attorneys with principal responsibility for preparation of the government's response have been heavily engaged with the press of previously assigned matters with proximate due dates.

Counsel for petitioner does not oppose this further extension.
