Petitioner-Appellant Alexis Negron-Cruz seeks a certificate of appealability in relation to the district court's denial of his motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §2255. After careful review of the record below and of the petitioner's submissions before us, we conclude that the district court's resolution of his claims was neither debatable nor wrong, and that petitioner has therefore failed to make "a substantial showing of the denial of a constitutional right." 28 U.S.C. §2253(c)(2); see Slack v. McDaniel, 529 U.S. 473, 484 (2000).

Accordingly, the request for a certificate of appealability is denied. The appeal is hereby terminated.
